Pastor's Pen

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! Well, it sure has been a blessed month as our parishes have come together to worship as one. Thank you to Our Lady of the Holy Cross for hosting the Saturday Vigil Masses and to St. Matthew, the Apostle, for hosting on Sunday! As mentioned last week, there will be a slight change to our September schedule. St. Matthew, the Apostle, will host the Saturday Vigil Mass at 4:00 pm instead of Our Lady of the Holy Cross and St. Augustine will continue hosting on Sunday at 10:00 am. This is to ensure that OLHC, SA, and SMA all host on both Saturday and Sunday. Since the church at St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist is still in disrepair, Mass will be limited to one all-school Mass (St. Louis Catholic Academy) per week, which will be celebrated every Monday at 9:00 am in the school gym (Beginning 9/11).

Monday, August 28th, marks the Feast of St. Augustine! Happy Feast Day to our brothers and sisters from St. Augustine parish! What a saint we have in him! Along with St. Ambrose, Pope St. Gregory I, and St. Jerome, St. Augustine is considered one of the "Great Fathers of the Western Church." One of the most well-known conversions in the history of Christianity is attributed this extraordinary saint. Check out his *Confessions* to learn more! Also, if you're really up for a challenge, consider reading his famous work, *The City of God.* St. Augustine, pray for us!

In our Gospel this weekend, Jesus entrusts Peter with the "the keys to the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 16:19). The Church recognizes this passage as the institution of the papacy, Jesus making Peter the first pope! In the Davidic kingdom, the possessor of the keys was the chief steward, the senior official, who held the most powerful position in Israel under the king (Note our 1st Reading: Isaiah 22:19-23). When the king was away, the "master of the palace" would govern in his stead. Now that our King, the King of Kings, has ascended into heaven, Peter and his successors act as vicars of Christ here on earth. So, on this Sunday when we honor the "Office of Peter" in our Gospel, let us pray for our holy father, Pope Francis, that he may shepherd our Church according to the Heart of Christ!

You all remain in my daily prayers! God bless and keep you always!

St. Augustine Happy Feast Day (August 28)

Saint Augustine (354-430) created this poetic prayer to the Holy Spirit:

Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit,
That my thoughts may all be holy.
Act in me, O Holy Spirit,
That my work, too, may be holy.
Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit,
That I love but what is holy.
Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit,
To defend all that is holy.
Guard me, then, O Holy Spirit,
That I always may be holy.

St Augustine of Hippo was also called Aurelius Augustinus.

He was a philosopher, theologian, and the bishop of Hippo Regius in Numidia, North Africa.

He was born on November 13 354 in Thagaste, Numidia in the modern-day Souk Ahras, Algeria, and died on August 28 430 at the age of 75 in Hippo Regius, Numidia (modern-day Annaba, Algeria).

We celebrate his feast day on <u>August 28</u> every year in the Catholic Church.

Any child or youth in the second grade or older who has been baptized: There will be a **mandatory orientation meeting** for parents (only) of children preparing to receive First Holy Communion (Eucharist) this year.

† Confirmation:

Any youth who has been baptized and must be in grades 7th - 12th and at least 12 years of age at the time of the administration of the Sacrament. All candidates and their families must attend an information session prior to enrollment.

† All other sacramental needs: Contact the parish office.

<u>Sacramental Preparation</u>: If you or anyone you know is in need of **any** sacrament, please contact the parish office immediately. It will soon be too late to enroll in many of these sessions this school year.
